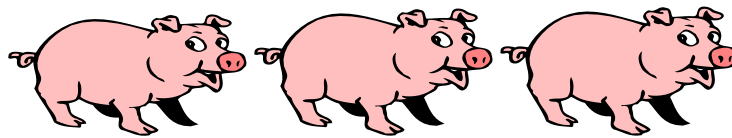


Abbeywood Tots (Station Road)

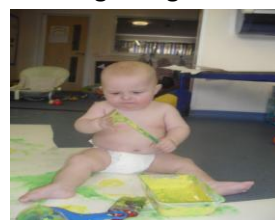
Diddy Dance
