WHITE WINE

1. CHARDONNAY, Vin de Pays d'Oc, France

£ 14.00

Produced from the same grape variety as Chablis, this is an unoaked fruity wine with hints of honey and acacia.

2. CHENIN BLANC, South Africa

£ 14.00

The Coastal Region, North-East of Cape Town produces this floral wine redolent of exotic fruits.

3. COLOMBARD, Vin de Pays des Cotes de Gascogne, France

£ 14.00

Dry wine produced from Colombard grape grown in the picturesque region of Gascony in Southwest France, home of Armagnac and the Three Musketeers.

4. BELLEFONTAINE SAUVIGNON BLANC, Vin de Pays d'Oc

£ 14.00

Produced from the same grape as Sancerre, this crisp wine has a fresh gooseberry aroma and flavour.

5. ANDES PEAK Reserva CHARDONNAY, Chile

£ 15.50

From one of the world's largest producers of organic wines.

ALSACE

6. GEWURZTRAMINER RESERVE

£ 18.50

A powerfully aromatic wine with floral, spicy, lychee notes. It has richness and length. It can be served as an aperitif, but it is also an ideal food wine and goes well with strongly flavoured cheeses.

7. PINOT GRIS, Cave de Turckheim

£ 18.50

Delicious fruity aroma with hints of walnuts and almonds. A full-bodied wine, capable of accompanying meat dishes as an alternative to red wine.





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LOIRE

8. SAUVIGNON DE TOURAINE, Domaine du Pré Baron £ 15.50

A fruity, crisp wine, which goes perfectly with fish and seafood

9. MENETOU SALON, Domaine Henri Pelle £ 24.00

This superb wine with ripe gooseberry aroma and flavour comes from a single Domaine, owned by the Mayor's family.

10. SANCERRE, Domaine Sarry £ 24.00

Produced from Sauvignon Blanc, this dry wine is ideal with fish, white meats.

11. VOUVRAY, Demi-Sec, Les Coteaux Tufiers, Loire Valley £17.50

This medium dry wine has great finesse, with a refreshing acidity, attractive fruit and a lingering nutty, buttery finish from ageing a few months in new oak.

BURGUNDY

12. CHABLIS, Louis Moreau £ 24.00

This is a fresh and supple wine produced from vineyards on the banks of the river Serein.

13. CHABLIS, 1er Cru Vaillons, Louis Moreau £ 27.00

Aromas of peach, flower and honey with austere mineral notes on the palate, elegant and classy wine. The Premier Cru vineyards surround the town of Chablis.

CHILE

14. VILLARD CHARDONNAY Expression, Chile £ 16.50

Delicate varietal aromas with a perfect balance of fruit ripeness and acidity, given added complexity from ageing several months in French barriques.

ROSE WINES

15. CASAL MENDES ROSE N.V., Portugal £ 15.50

A medium-dry rose with a slight sparkle produced in the Bairrada region

16. MAS MACIA CAVA ROSE, Catalunya, Spain £ 17.50

Produced by the methode traditionnelle (like Champagne) this wine offers a pronounced redcurrant aroma with a fresh raspberry juicy palate. Superb with strawberries and cream.





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17. Windowrie Reserve Sparkling SHIRAZ, Cowra, Australia £ 17.50

Aromas of black cherries, chocolate and coffee. The sweet black berry fruit and mocha notes on the palate make this wine a perfect match with chocolate,

SPARKLING WINE

18. VEUVE DE BOMONDE BRUT £ 16.50

Produced in the Loire by the Charmat Method, this sparkling wine has a floral biscuity aroma, a wonderful creamy fruit and good length on the palate. The mousse is delicate and long lasting, Excellent as an aperitif or to celebrate a special occasion.

CHAMPAGNE

19. CHAMPAGNE GREMILLET BRUT N.V. £ 29.50

This very smooth champagne is produced from Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Pinot Meunier. Pale lemon colour, excellent mousse of fine and persistent bubbles, fresh nose, crisp but rich fruit; long and elegant on the palate.

20. CHAMPAGNE GREMILLET Grande Reserve N.V. ½ bottle £ 17.00

21. CHAMPAGNE DE VENOGUE N.V. Cordon Bleu £ 32.00

Established in 1864, the Epernay-based champagne De Venoge has earned a reputation for excellence.

RED WINES

22. CABERNET SAUVIGNON, Vin de Pays d'Oc £ 14.00

Ripe blackcurranty style with a restrained French character, well-structured, fairly full bodied with fruit and soft tannin

23. BELLEFONTAINE MERLOT, Vin de Pays d'Oc £ 14.00

From the same grape variety as Saint-Emilion wines, this is a smooth and plummy wine.

24. LAZY LIZARD SHIRAZ, Vin de Pays d'Oc £ 14.00

A spicy and chunky wine. The stylish label is inspired by the small lizards which bask in the vineyards.





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BORDEAUX

- 25. CLARET DUBOSCQ N.V.** £ 17.50
Supple, rounded well-balanced wine.
- 26. FRONSAC, Chateau Mayne Vieil** £ 18.50
Produced from 90% Merlot grape in the hilly countryside west of Pomerol and Saint Emilion, this wine has a rich flavour with a firm finish.
- 27. CHATEAU RAMAGE LA BATISSE, Haut-Medoc, Cru Bourgeois** £ 27.00
The Haut-Medoc is the Southern half of the strip north of Bordeaux on the Left bank of the Gironde Estuary. The predominance of Cabernet Sauvignon gives the wines characteristic blackcurrant fruit and firm texture.
- 28. CHATEAU GIRAUELS de MILON, Grand Cru Classe Saint-Emilion** £ 21.50
This classy wine offers a combination of concentration and complexity.
- 29. CHATEAU MOUTON-ROTHSCHILD 1986**
1er Cru Classe Pauillac £750.00
An intense and refined aroma with a hint of truffles, on the palate. A wine of complex, balanced majestic richness.

RHONE VALLEY

- 30. COTES DU RHONE-VILLAGES** £ 18.50
Produced from Syrah and Grenache this wine brings the Mediterranean sunshine into your glass.
- 31. CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE, Domaine Chante Cigale** £ 26.50
All estate-bottled Chateauneuf-du-Pape are sold in a bottle with St Peter's crossed keys, embossed on the shoulder. Some of the vines are 50 to 80 years old contributing complexity and richness to the wines which are aged in oak vats before bottling.





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BURGUNDY

32. FLEURIE

£ 21.50

Fleurie is a wine with all the exuberance of the countryside in the spring; fragrant with aromas of iris and violet. Some people like to drink it chilled, others at room temperature.

33. BEAUNE EPENOTTES, Premier Cru, Vallet Freres

£ 28.50

This elegant wine, vinified in oak, has a complex bouquet redolent of black cherries, wild blackberries and peaches. A seductive and velvety wine, very complex on the palate with a lingering finish.

SOUTH AFRICA

34. FALSE BAY PINOTAGE

£ 15.50

A cross of Pinot Noir and Cinsaut, this unique South African grape, produces a full-bodied wine with notes of strawberries and damson plums.

SPAIN

35. RIOJA crianza

£ 20.50

A "Crianza" Rioja with oak ageing for one year and normally bottled in the third year after harvest.

36. RIOJA RESERVA

£ 23.00

A seductive velvety wine produced in the Rioja Alta region from 70 % Tempranillo, 20 % Garnacha and 10 % Mazuelo. The maturing for 36 months in American oak casks contributes aromas of sweet vanilla and nutmeg.

37. RIOJA GRAN RESERVA, Monte Real

£ 28.50

The long maturing in American oak casks contributes aromas of sweet vanilla and nutmeg.

38. RIOJA CRIANZA Puerta Vieja (1/2 bottle)

£ 11.00

AUSTRALIA

39. Taltarni "T" Series SHIRAZ/CABERNET, Victoria

£ 18.50

From one of the founding wineries of the Victorian Pyrenees. Spicy ripe fruit makes this wine a perfect accompaniment to a wide range of dishes and cheese.

40. FONTY'S POOL PINOT NOIR, Western Australia

£ 19.50

Vinified at Cape Mentelle facility, the wine shows the true expression of the region and offers purity of fruit, smooth tannins with a smoky raspberry finish.

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41. FONTY'S POOL SHIRAZ, Western Australia **£ 19.50**
Spicy sweet ripe fruit, subtle smoky oak aroma, hints of pepper and fresh blackcurrant make this wine an ideal accompaniment for roast duck or spicy dishes.

42. THE LANE REUNION SHIRAZ, **£ 32.50**
Adelaide Hills, South Australia. Where the New World meets the Old. This wine offers the structure and elegance of France with the intense fruit and sunshine of Australia.

CHILE

43. ANDES PEAK RESERVE CABERNET SAUVIGNON **£ 17.50**
A smooth and complex wine with blackcurrant and chocolate flavours.

DESSERT WINE

44. MUSCAT DE RIVESALTES (France) **£ 18.50**
A delicious sweet Muscat wine made from overripe grapes to intensify the sweet floral character. Ideal with cheese and puddings or simply on its own as an aperitif.

Similar to Sauternes, this luscious wine is ideal with cheese and puddings or simply on its own as an aperitif.
