

To care for your leather it is recommended that under average use, maintenance should be carried out at least every 6 months. This will maintain the strength, character, and general appearance of the leather. With correct maintenance, leather will last a lifetime.

□ □ Floors

Accidental Spillages

Wipe up spillages immediately with a clean cloth or sponge. Gently clean with lukewarm clean water. Allow to dry and repolish (see periodical cleaning).

Daily Cleaning □

Maintain with regular vacuuming and occasional dusting with a damp cloth and lukewarm water.

Periodical Cleaning (every 3-6 months)

Apply a Beeswax polish with a lint free cloth in a circular motion. Allow to dry and buff with a horse-hair brush or fine buffing pad on a rotary polishing machine.

□ Walls

Accidental Spillages

Wipe up spillages immediately with a clean cloth or sponge. Gently clean with lukewarm clean water. Allow to dry and repolish

Daily Cleaning □

Maintain with regular vacuuming and occasional dusting with a damp cloth with lukewarm water.

Periodical Cleaning (every 3-6 months)

To maintain the natural beauty of the panels and to restore the leather's natural oils and supple appearance, Harcourt leather maintenance products should also be used periodically.

□ □ Furniture

Accidental Spillages

Wipe up spillages immediately with a clean cloth or sponge. Gently clean with lukewarm clean water, cleaning the entire area. Allow to dry naturally and repolish.

Daily Cleaning □

Regular vacuuming with soft brush to remove dust and crumbs.

Periodical Cleaning (every 3-6 months)

Occasional dusting with a damp cloth, lukewarm water and mild soap, wring out the cloth well before using on leather. To maintain the natural beauty of the panels and to restore the leather's natural oils and supple appearance, Harcourt leather maintenance products should also be used periodically.

Other leather cleaners such as saddle soap or household cleaners that may contain harsh chemicals, alcohol or ink removers should never be used on leather panels. Avoid placing leather in direct sunlight or near heat sources.
