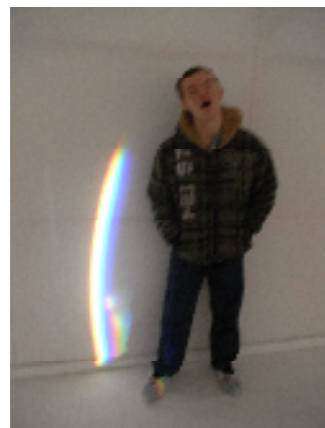


The Loyne Specialist School
