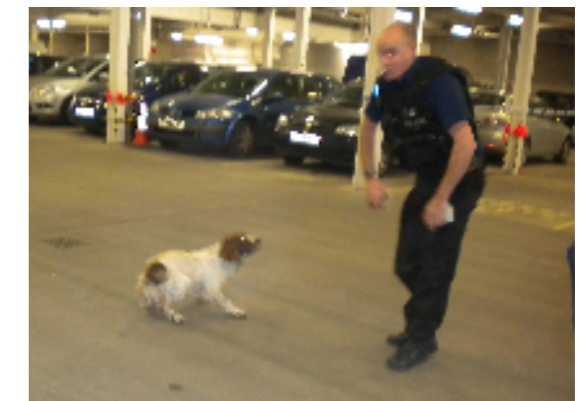
### SWITZERLAND 2010
