







CURRICULUM INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Class Smart Start	Term Summer 2010
<p>Personal Social & Emotional Development</p>	 <p>Our theme this term is Animals. We will think about how to care for animals and investigate how Buddhists treat animals. We will read stories such as Little Red Hen and discuss how we should all help each other.</p>
<p>Communication Language And Literacy</p>	 <p>We will be reading many stories featuring animals, including Dear Zoo, Monkey Puzzle, Rumble in The Jungle, Old MacDonald, Little Red Hen, Rosie's Walk, and Farmyard Hullabaloo.</p>
<p>Problem Solving, Reasoning and Numeracy</p>	 <p>Our number work will be based around counting animals and counting the number of legs, wings, beaks etc on animals. We will sing number songs with an animal theme and complete surveys about favourite animals.</p>
<p>Knowledge And Understanding Of the World</p>	 <p>We will learn about farm and zoo animals. As part of our Out and About days this term we hope to visit Greenlands Farm, Williamson's Park and Blackpool zoo.</p>
<p>Physical Development</p>	 <p>We will create and dance and movements linked to animals. We will use The Carnival Of Animals as a theme to our dance. We will also access large play equipment to climb, slither and swing.</p>
<p>Creative Development</p>	 <p>There will be lots of creative opportunities to make pictures, models and dressing up as different animals. We will use musical instruments to recreate animal sounds and learn lots of songs about animals.</p>
