



### Construction of a New Sports Pavilion

The project involved construction of a new sports pavilion for the local community and sports teams in the area. The new building comprises six changing rooms, each with their own showering facilities, while two of the changing rooms offer showering facilities for those with disabilities. Other facilities include two referee's changing rooms, male, female and disabled WCs, a seminar/meeting room, kitchen, disabled access, and internal and external storage facilities. As part of the development an existing car park was resurfaced.
