1. **How to bring remedies alive** – By creating a 'living map' of a remedy we bring the dynamics within a remedy to a point of new understanding. From this new 'view' we can gain a deep insight into how remedy states manifest and move through individuals
2. **The deepening and unprejudiced observer within** – participating in constellations gives an experience of what it's like to walk in someone else's shoes
3. **The hidden dynamics at work with patients and in the consulting room** – what part is the homeopath playing in the case? Is there an obstacle to cure? Is there an aspect of the case/dynamic that has been missed?
4. **Opportunities to work on difficult or stuck cases in a supervisory way** - participants can bring challenging cases to the workshop for a deeper exploration of the hidden systemic dynamics.
